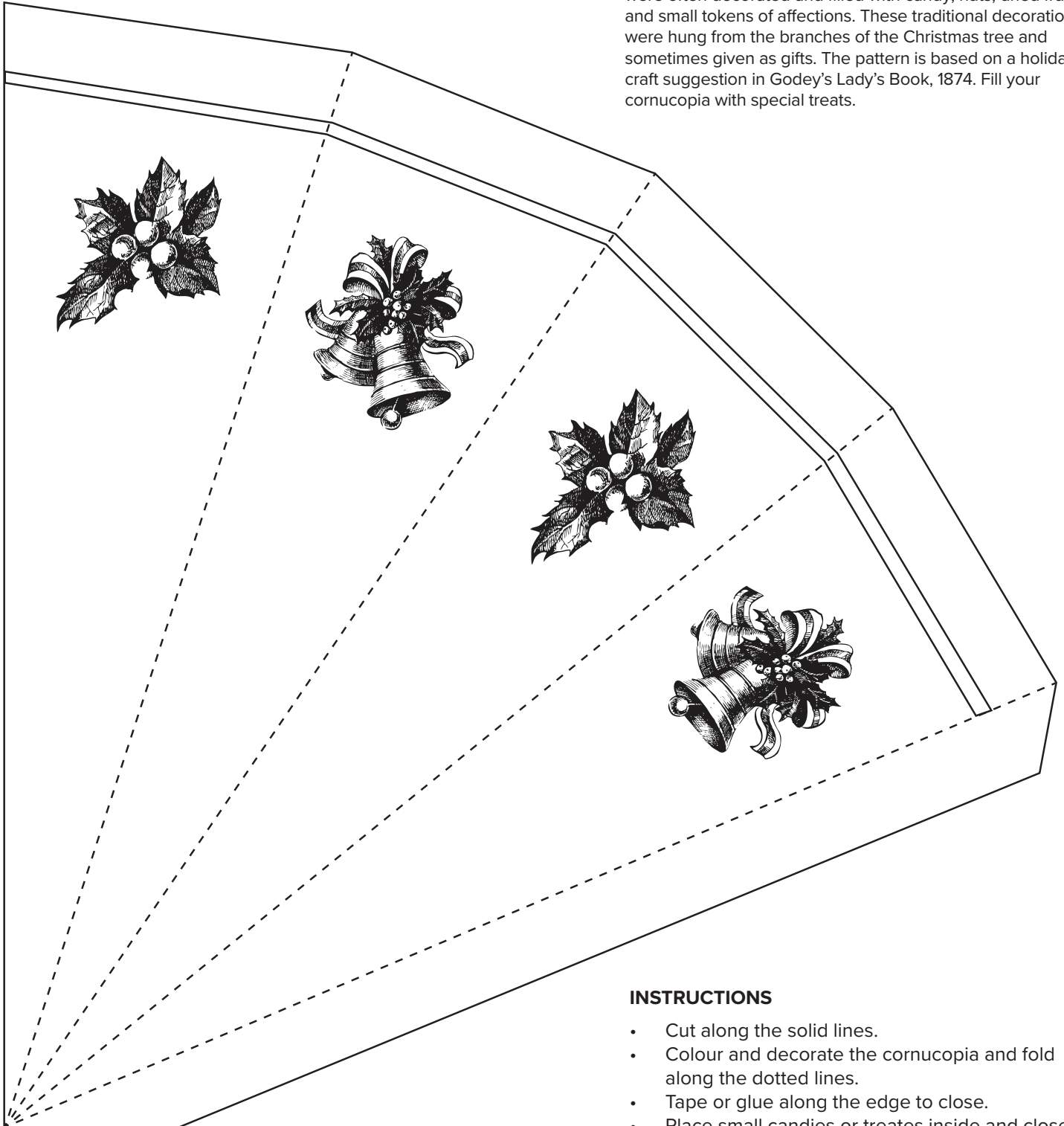


# HOW TO MAKE A CORNUCOPIA

**A CORNUCOPIA**, is a horn or cone shaped container. It is a time-honoured symbol, long associated with abundance. During the Victorian era, paper or lace cones were often decorated and filled with candy, nuts, dried fruits and small tokens of affections. These traditional decorations were hung from the branches of the Christmas tree and sometimes given as gifts. The pattern is based on a holiday craft suggestion in Godey's Lady's Book, 1874. Fill your cornucopia with special treats.



## INSTRUCTIONS

- Cut along the solid lines.
- Colour and decorate the cornucopia and fold along the dotted lines.
- Tape or glue along the edge to close.
- Place small candies or treats inside and close the lid.
- Ribbon or wire can be added to make a handle to hang or carry the cornucopia.
